Strap leaf caladiums are here! Gingerland and Florida Sweetheart strap leaves are considered more heat and sun tolerant than fancy leaf caladiums. The strap leaf type have smaller, narrower, thicker, and elongated leaves on short petioles giving the plants a more compact habit. Strap leaf caladiums produce more leaves per tuber than fancy leaf caladiums. Height is 12" to 14." Uses: hanging baskets, borders, plantings in front of fancy type. Prices start at \$0.70/bulb with a minimum of 5 of any one variety.

Fancy leaf caladiums have large heart shaped leaves ranging in height from 18" to 22". Most prefer filtered shade or afternoon shade with morning sun. Varieties that tolerate full sun are Carolyn Whorton, Red Flash, and White Queen. Candidums prefer shade. Prices start at \$0.60/bulb with a minimum of 5 of any one variety.

Bulbs are Grade #1 rated (1 1/2" - 2 1/2" size bulbs). This year we are offering discounts on larger purchases. Quantities are based on same variety order. Bulbs will be delivered at the April Master Gardener meeting.
